

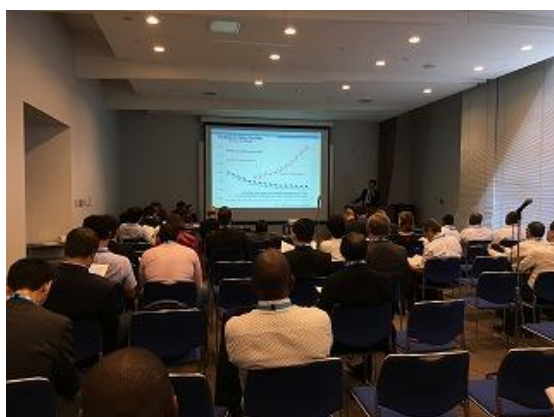
International Events at IWA World Water Congress & Exhibition 2018

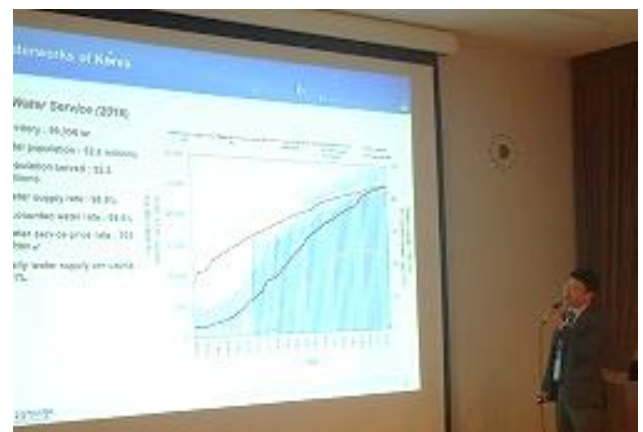


2. IWA Workshop (Thursday September 20, 13:30-15:00)
